

# GRINDER Time Board Design Brief

The Grinder Time Board promotes the competitive spirit between community members as well as motivating users to improve their own time.



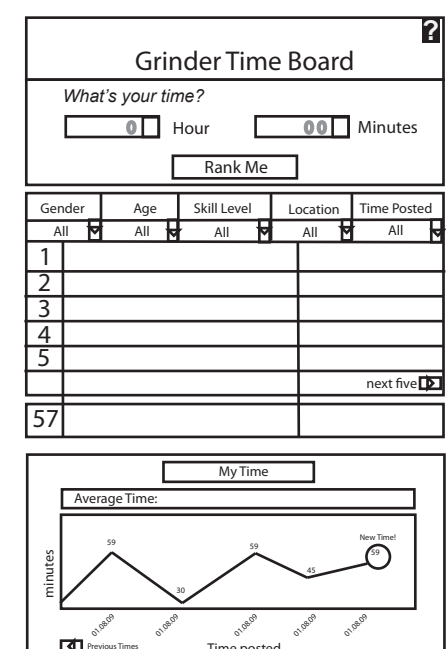
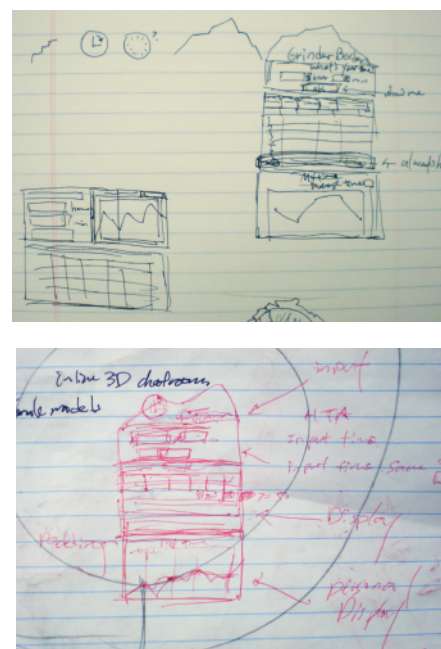
- 1 Users can use both the numeric stepper tool and the keyboard to input their time. As a way of preventing error, neither of the input boxes accept negative numbers, and the minute box does not accept numbers greater than 60.
- 2 Throughout the UI, dynamic buttons communicate the state of operation by change colors as users mouse over them.
- 3 The top tabs list out the categories in which the user can choose to sort the leader board. Detail options are shown by clicking on the drop down menu below it, as suggested by a downturned triangle.
- 4 To strengthen the community aspect of the application, the user can click on the name of their fellow members to view their profile, friend them, and add them to their group.
- 5 After clicking "Rank me", the input time is highlighted and displayed on the board even if it's not in the top 10.
- 6 The page jumping function matches the mental model of existing page jumping functions. It is also kept consistent with the page function on the My Time section of the board.
- 7 Best, Average, and Worst times, as well as the chart helps the user keep track of his or her hiking record.
- 8 The latest time is display after the user clicks "Rank Me".
- 9 Clicking on the small "x" opens the option for the user to delete their time.
